## **VIDEO GAME COLLECTION**


- 3 Week Checkout, no renewals

### PRESCHOOL AND SUMMER CAMP VISITS

- Weekly storytimes for preschool classes at Belle Haven Child Development Center and Menlo Children's Center
- Visits to Camp Menlo and Menlo Mania, alternating with weeks where they visited the libraries
  - Storytime for children in grades K-2
  - Literacy games and activities for grades 3-5
- Prize books at the start and end of each session
- Color-in paper reading logs for preschoolers, and sticker badge books for school-age children







- 13 library staff doing storytimes and Big Kid Activities
- 4 storytime visits per week
- ~55 staff hours spent with summer camps/preschools over the summer session
- 567 free books given to preschool and summer camp enrollees







### **SUMMER READING GAME**

- Registration and participation tracking through the Beanstack website/app
- Book Bingo cards (online or on paper) in place of traditional reading logs
- Prizes!
  - Free book for signing up
  - Free book and raffle ticket for completing Bingo
    - Raffle tickets put towards 1 of 12 themed prize baskets
- Events for all ages





### **SUMMER EVENT HIGHLIGHTS**

- Biweekly outdoor events in place of Thursday morning storytimes
  - Summer Puppetry Festival, animal visits, and musical guests
- Summer Reading Kickoff Party
  - Ice cream, crafts, summer reading signups and books
- Library Adventure
  - Costumed scavenger hunts for all age groups at Main Library
- Summer Reading Finale Party
  - Pizza, carnival games, onsite raffles and books























- ~450 adult and teen books
- ~1,300 children's books
- Over 1/3 played to completion

- Outdoor family events drew an average 180 attendees per event
- Kickoff and Finale parties drew ~250 attendees across both libraries
- Library Adventure drew 200+
