- To help develop a potential “hybrid” operating model with input from Belle Haven neighborhood residents and stakeholders, for future City Council review and consideration.

6:15 What is the proposed Belle Haven Pool “hybrid” operating model?

- A concept for a community-oriented swim center jointly operated by the City of Menlo Park (City) and Menlo Swim and Sport (Operator)
- The Operator would provide:
 - Safety services, including certified lifeguards. lifeguard training and management support
 - Certified Pool Operator (CPO) support.
- The City would provide:
 - Aquatic programs such as swim lessons, swim teams, aqua fit.
 - Customer service support and registration
 - Program supervisory oversight.
- The City would collect and retain all revenue from swim fees
- The City would compensate the Operator \$199 per hour for two certified lifeguards, one lifeguard manager and the associated overhead costs, plus \$600 per week for the CPO support.
