Background information

The purpose of the Task Force is to gather neighborhood-oriented feedback and ideas to help shape and develop a potential "hybrid" operating model at Belle Haven Pool for future consideration by City Council. The proposed Belle Haven Pool "hybrid" operating model is an idea for operating the community swim center at Belle Haven Pool (other ideas are welcome, too). The proposal/idea is:

- Belle Haven Pool would be jointly operated by the City of Menlo Park and Menlo Swim and Sport
- Menlo Swim and Sport (Operator) would provide:
 - o Safety services certified lifeguards, lifeguard training and supervision
 - Certified Pool Operator (CPO) water treatment, etc.
- The City of Menlo Park would provide, either via city staff and/or contractors:
 - Aquatic programs family swim, lap swim, swim lessons, aqua fit, etc.
 - o Customer service
 - Schedule of pool hours and aquatics programs.
- Financial details
 - o The City would collect and retain all revenue from user fees
 - The City would compensate the Operator \$199 per hour for two certified lifeguards, one lifeguard manager and overhead costs, and \$600 per week for the CPO support.
